Volunteers must:

- Be at least 16 years of age, and 18 years of age to volunteer with the dogs.
- Be self-motivated, mature, dependable, compassionate, and capable of completing complicated tasks, independently. Individuals who cannot volunteer independently must always volunteer in the company of another adult capable of assisting them, who has attended orientation and completed required training.
- Be able to squat, bend, twist, lift or stand for long periods.
- Be able to commit to one consistent shift per week for a minimum of 3 months
- **Court Ordered Community Service** requires a separate application which can be found on the Volunteer Website. Please do not submit this application for Court Ordered Community Service.
